- All 2024–2025 school year taxes have been submitted, balanced, and e-filed by the accountant.
- The PTA is appealing the 2023–2024 taxes, which were filed late and incurred a penalty.
- Reimbursements: Anyone requesting reimbursement must complete a Reimbursement Form, which will be available at every PTA meeting.
- The accountant recommended transferring \$15,000 in carryover funds into a separate savings account to make the funds less easily accessible.
