What can be reported?

- Bullying or harrassment
- Safety concerns
- Situations where a student may need help

Why it matters

Early reporting helps connect students to support before situations escalate.

If something doesn't feel right, say something.
Together, we can help keep our community safe.

How it works

- Reports are received by trained counselors @ Sandy Hook Promise Crisis Center
- Counselors can open 2-way dialogue and reporter can share media(screenshots/pics)
- Information is shared with local school and safety teams so continued support and/or intervention can be provided
