Public Observation Policy for L&A Testing

Participating as an observer during Logic and Accuracy Testing provides the public a chance to observe how voting equipment is tested for security and integrity prior to voters casting ballots. This document outlines expected behavior from the public during observation. If anyone fails to meet these standards, you may be asked to leave.

- **Observation Designations:**
 - **Designated Party Observers** are appointed by the party chair of recognized political parties.
 - **Members of the General Public**, including **Media** and **Candidates** may also attend but may be asked to sit in a separate area.
- **Location:** Observers will be permitted only in designated observation areas and will not be permitted to interact with the voting equipment.
- **Electronics:**
 - Phone calls are not permitted in the tabulation center. Please silence your phone and step outside to take calls.
 - Photographs, videos, or recordings (including audio) are not permitted in the tabulation center. Media requests should be arranged in advance of testing with the Elections Department.
- **Time:** Observation is permitted for the duration of the test. However, it is the observer's responsibility to be on time and testing will proceed regardless of whether an observer is late or needs to leave early.
- **Behavior:**
 - Observers may not touch the tabulation equipment, test ballots, or any other items being used for the L&A test.
 - Please be respectful to the elections staff and other observers present. Derogatory comments and behavior that disrupts the test will not be tolerated.
 - Please write questions or issues on the provided observation forms. We will describe the testing as it is conducted and address questions as time allows.
