

Dear Board of Supervisors,

I have attached a copy of the State Grant In Aid narrative and budget form to give you the opportunity to review it, if you choose, before the Board meeting on October 21, 2014. Since I will be on vacation, one of the district's senior administrators will present the item to the Board. If you have any questions concerning this grant please feel free to contact me before October 16, 2014 so I can answer your questions.

This is a non-competitive annual grant from the Arizona State Library. I can confirm that we have received this grant for the last 18 years.

The column on the fiscal report labeled **Local Funds** represents funds in our operating budget that we have allocated for comparable travel, collections and postage. In the matter of **Library Collection Materials**, \$45,000 represents our district budget for electronic materials including proprietary research databases, FirstSearch database to support interlibrary loans (ILL) and digital books.

When administering the funds of the SGIA I apply them as equitably as possible. One of the best ways to do that is to use the bulk of the grant to purchase electronic materials, eBooks, eAudios and streaming videos that may be accessed remotely with library card authentication. Any resident who has been issued a library card may check out these materials without having to travel to a library for the materials.

ILL stands for **interlibrary loan**. When an Apache County resident wants a title that we do not own in our system, we place a request to borrow it through the services of OCLC FirstSearch (Online Computer Library Center, "a worldwide library cooperative, which provides and improves access to the world's information") of which we are a member in good standing. We do not charge our residents for this service or for the postage to obtain or to return an item. Therefore, although we might not own an item, we provide access to it. Likewise we share our collections with other libraries throughout the country too. This service has consistently grown in popularity with our residents over the past several years.

The majority of staff travel consists of attending monthly managers' meetings in St. Johns. The meetings consist of presentations, discussions, training, and problem solving among the branch managers. This year, our Public Services Coordinator, organized a cross-training program called managers' exchange, whereby each of our library managers trains with a colleague for a day and then shortly afterwards serves for one day as the library manager for that library. In addition, I am obligated to attend two County Librarians' meetings a year, and as North Region Representative for the Arizona Library Association, I attend quarterly meetings in the Phoenix area. These funds may also be applied to my travel in an official capacity.

The SGIA grant is a completely online process. Therefore, I have taken screen shots of each step and scanned them into a pdf for your convenience. I have also included the SGIA Regulations and Guidelines, the Arizona State Library Resource Access and Attainment Policy, and the Apache County Library District Resource Access and Attainment Policy as approved by the Board of Supervisors on November 2, 2010.

Please let me know if I can be of further assistance to you in this matter.

NARRATIVE

Description of expected use of SGIA funds:

The Apache County Library District will utilize SGIA funds to continue to enhance our lending digital collection, as well as to supplement postage and travel expenses.

In our continuing effort to realize our Technology Vision Statement: *Develop, incorporate, and maintain current technologies to broaden the degree and efficiency of access to local and remote information*, we will spend the bulk of our SGIA funds to continue to build our digital audio, streaming video and digital text collection.

Our circulation statistics confirm that fictional works continue to be the most popular digital titles among our library card holders. However, this year we experienced a 47% increase in the circulation of non-fiction titles. Therefore, in response to local demand we shall continue to build our non-fiction digital collection. We will also enhance our electronic audio collection since this format realized a 325% increase in circulation over the previous year.

For the last three years, we hosted numerous workshops throughout the district to provide our residents instruction in the use of a variety of digital readers. Several people used the information and exposure to a variety of devices to determine which model to purchase for their personal use. In June 2014 we launched an advertising campaign, including word-of-mouth, posters and newspaper advertisements featuring our digital books collection. As a result we increased circulation 33% over May 2014. This year we will continue to raise our residents' awareness of our digital collections, as well as select and train one staff member for each library to serve as digital trainer for the staff of that branch.

Over the last several years, our staff has made a concerted effort to increase our residents' awareness of our interlibrary loan services. For those patrons whose reading interests exceed the scope of our collections either because titles are out of print or because we don't own the entire body of work for an individual author, or because residents seek in-depth information on subjects of interest to them, this is a critical and valuable service that provides access to these materials.

As part of the interlibrary loan service we not only borrow items but we lend to other libraries. Due to the fact that our library district has been able to adhere to a regular schedule for downloading our holdings records to OCLC it has resulted in an increase in titles lent to other libraries. Although we are still a net borrower, every year we inch towards becoming a net lender. In order to maintain these vital services and meet our consistently growing demand for ILL requests, we will use SGIA funds to supplement our postage budget.

The remainder of our grant funds will be used to reimburse staff for travel to meetings within the district, for our library managers' cross-training exchange program, and for travel to County Librarians' meetings.

SGIA Regulations and Guidelines

Background

The state grants-in-aid program was developed in 1981 through legislative appropriations to help Arizona libraries meet the information needs for Arizona residents.

SGIA Criteria:

- Be organized as a governmental unit or a non-profit organization.
- Arizona public libraries must agree to the Arizona State Library Resource Access and Attainment Policy.
- Provide library services free of charge to all residents within the library area. *following*
- Be open to the public on a regular basis with regular, posted hours.
- Be in good standing with the State Library by submitting library statistics and all other reports in a complete, accurate and timely manner.
- Adhere to any requirements specified in the Arizona Revised Statutes, including but not limited to ARS 9-411 through 9-420 (Cities and Towns/Public Libraries); ARS 11-901 through 11-914 (Counties/Public Libraries); and ARS 34-502 (Computer Access/Harmful to Minors).

Use of SGIA Funds:

- State funds will be used for library services county or citywide. Funds will not be used for indirect or administrative costs.
- County/city will expend no less than the amount of state grants-in-aid awarded in the same fiscal year for county/citywide library services. SGIA requires a dollar-for-dollar cash match. State money may not be substituted for local match.
- The applicant library agrees to submit a final report, which will include a narrative, budget and certification.

Arizona Resource Access and Attainment Policy (AzRAP) for Regents and Community Colleges:

Receive:

- Access to FirstSearch Worldcat to all regent and community college members.

Agree To:

- ILL materials to other Arizona public, regent or community college members, with postage charges capped at \$6 per item.
- Write and publish a detailed Resource Access and Attainment Policy, and provide an electronic copy to the Arizona State Library each time the policy is updated.

SGIA and LSTA

All county and municipal library systems receiving regular SGIA allotments must be AzRAP compliant. All public libraries applying for LSTA must be AzRAP compliant. To be eligible for LSTA competitive grants, any type of library must be AzRAP compliant.

Libraries may limit ILL requests to six per patron at any one time and may limit requests to print materials published more than one year ago; not currently on a nationally recognized best-seller list; or not needed by the library's own patrons. The sharing of circulating non-print materials is encouraged, but not required.
- Write and publish a detailed Resource Access and Attainment Policy, and provide an electronic copy to the Arizona State Library each time the policy is updated.

The Apache County Library District is committed to working with our public to find information they need and want, and to obtain material needed for that information. In accordance with the Arizona State Library Resource Access and Attainment Policy, the Library District agrees to:

1. Work with patrons, at no charge, to locate materials.
2. Provide specific information on obtaining material. Patrons may be offered several options to obtain material including: patron purchase of low-cost materials; library purchase of materials; database and web sources; and inter-library loan (ILL).
3. When materials can only be obtained through ILL, offer to secure the loan for the patron. Postage costs for books sent to any and from any library (capped at \$3 each way), and fees charged by non Arizona public, regent or community college libraries, may be passed on to the patron; no other fees or charges may be passed on to the patron.
4. Provide materials to other Arizona public, regent, or community college members at no charge.

Library District patrons may request and/or borrow a maximum of six ILL items at a time. Patrons must check out ILL materials using their library cards, and sign for all ILL materials as well. Patrons are responsible for returning these items, by the due date, to the same circulation desk and branch where they borrowed the items. If a patron loses or damages an ILL item, consistently returns items late, or consistently neglects to pick up items, the Library District or any of its branches reserves the right to suspend the patron's ILL privileges.



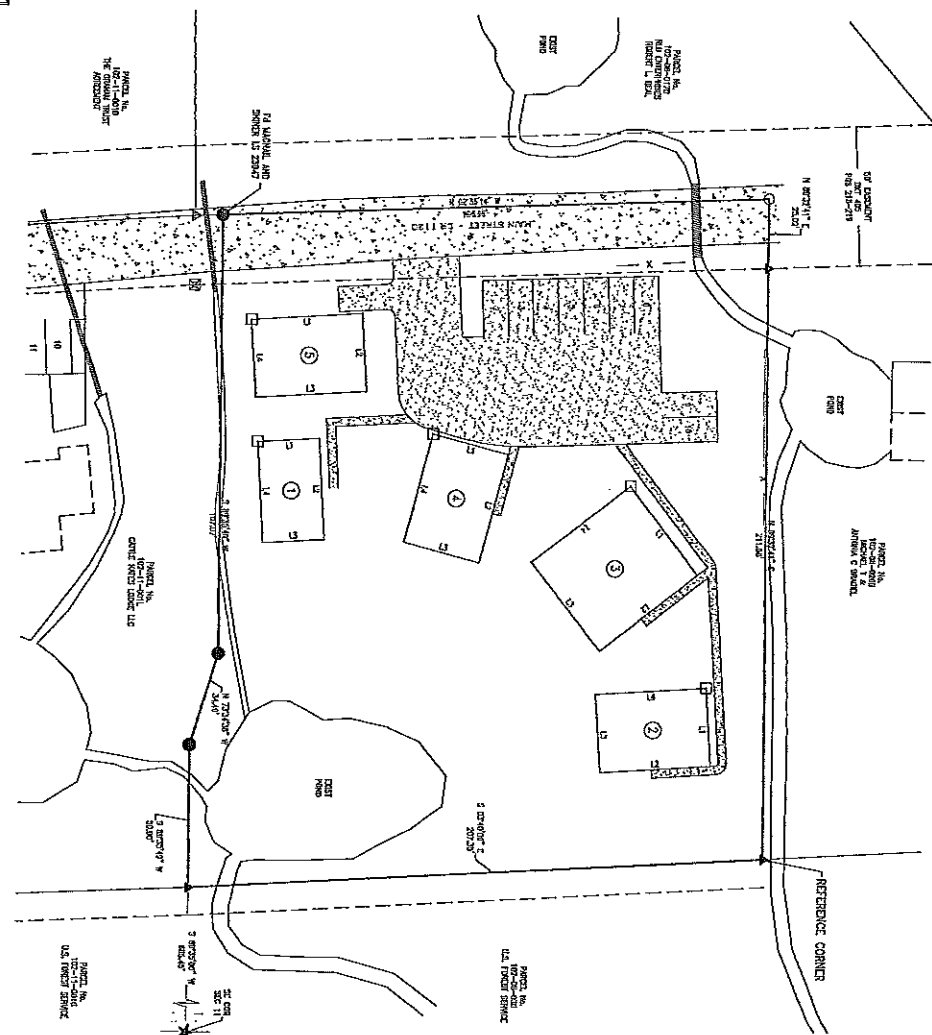

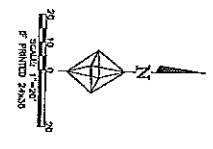

October 7, 2014
St. Johns, Arizona

Present were: Chairman Tom M. White, Jr., Vice Chairman Barry Weller, County Manager/Clerk of the Board, Delwin Wengert and County Attorney Michael Whiting. Supervisor Joe Shirley, Jr. and Attorney Joseph Young participated via the telephone.

Chairman White called to order the Board of Supervisors, Flood Control District, Library District and Public Health Services District meetings at 8:32 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors chambers, County Annex Building, 75 West Cleveland Street, St. Johns, Arizona and welcomed all in attendance.

Kirk Arviso gave the Invocation.

Ben Dugdale led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman White called for the Library District items.

Judith Pepple, Library Director, requested approval of the donation of microfiche reader with spare bulbs, microfiche history of the Arizona State Legislature, and Dell OptiPlex computer to the Apache County Historical Society Museum. **Mr. Shirley moved approval, seconded by Mr. Weller.** Vote was unanimous.

Judith Pepple, Library Director, requested approval of a lease agreement from August 8, 2014 through June 30, 2015 between Apache County Library District and the Vernon Community Park Committee. **Mr. Weller moved approval, seconded by Mr. Shirley.** Vote was unanimous.

Mr. Weller moved to adjourn the Library District meeting, seconded by Mr. Shirley. Vote was unanimous.

Chairman White called for the Flood Control District item.

Ferrin Crosby, County Engineer, requested approval of a Flood Hazard Development Permit to allow Edward Cerra to install a portable cabin and build a future home. Mr. Crosby stated the property is located near Concho, parcel 107-30-020, Section 107-30. Township 11N. Range 26E and is located within the 100 year flood plain so in order to build there, the owners are required to go through a process and have completed all requirements. **Mr. Weller moved approval, seconded by Mr. Shirley.** After a discussion with the owner, Vote was unanimous to approve with conditions outlined in the permit.

Supervisors Shirley stated that before he needs be excused from the meeting, asked that items #8 and #15.

Ferrin Crosby, County Engineer presented the item for District III requesting approval of a resolution adding N3114 to the Apache County Road Maintenance System, utilizing District III funds. Mr. Shirley stated that it is his understanding that the a public hearing needs to be done on this item and asked to table the item until the proper notice is done in the paper. Mr. Weller stated he received various emails on this; the initial approval for today's item was given on this September 22, 2014 by Mr. Whiting and then later a memo was sent out by a Jarod Robinson. Mr. Weller asked Mr. Whiting who that person is. Mr. Whiting stated Mr. Robinson is a law clerk who works in his office. Mr. Weller asked if Mr. Robinson was an attorney. Mr. Whiting stated no, but he reviewed the memo and it is accurate. Mr. Weller stated he has a concern regarding the accuracy of the memo and a concern with holding up the item that would benefit the citizens. Mr. White asked Attorney Joe Young his opinion on the need for a public hearing. Mr. Young stated he also agrees with the memo and Mr. Whiting, and it comes down to a public policy argument as to what the purpose of a public hearing is, and the purpose is to flavor the supervisor's discussion before they take action. Mr. Young stated the public hearing that was held nine months ago decouples the public hearing from the Supervisor's action if it happened today so while there is no hard and fast rule of how much time can go by before a new public hearing is held, he thinks in the best interest of public input, it is needed. Mr. Weller stated he agrees with one area of the memo that "we do not want to give the appearance of impropriety" so he agrees with calling another public hearing to avoid the appearance of impropriety and move forward in that manner. Mr. Whiting stated that the notice would be published twice prior to 15 days before the public hearing is to be held. Chairman White tabled the item until it would be properly noticed.

Michael Whiting, County Attorney, requested approval to create the position of Senior Investigator (range 50) and promote Investigator Brian Hounshell to the position with the salary of \$61,283.18. **Mr. Shirley moved approval, seconded by Mr. White.** Mr. Weller stated he will not be able to support this action, that he had reviewed the wording of the new position to be created and the qualifications and to move forward with this action would be on the verge of

insulting all of the commanders and sergeants within the Sheriff's Office, with the work they do and the wages they make. Mr. Weller stated it is an affront to all of the employees who have tried to get raises throughout the past several decades of hard times and he cannot support this in any way. Mr. White asked if this would result in a cost savings. Mr. Whiting stated it won't result in any general fund increase; Ms. Capps (in another item coming before the board today) will be retiring and will come back part-time so that will be a cost saving of \$26,000 and Mr. Hounshell's raise will cost the office a little over \$9,000 so there is a savings of about \$17,000. Mr. Weller stated the letter he saw mentioned Mr. Latham is also leaving the department and asked if these numbers are absent of replacing Mr. Latham. Mr. Whiting stated with Mr. Latham leaving, it will result in a cost savings of \$23,087.12 if they replace him at the minimum of the salary. Motion passed 2-1 with Mr. Weller voting nay.

Michael Whiting, County Attorney's Office, requested authorization to hire Melody Capps as an independent contractor after her retirement of October 17, 2014, at a rate of \$17.00 per hour not to exceed 1040 hours per year, for a total maximum annual cost of \$17,680. **Mr. Shirley moved approval, seconded by Mr. Weller.** Mr. Weller asked if there were any issue related to rehiring and individual who is receiving Arizona Retirement and if the County is within statute guidelines to rehire her as an independent contractor. Mr. Whiting stated there were no issues. Vote was unanimous.

Supervisor Shirley asked to be excused from the remainder of the meeting. Chairman White excused Mr. Shirley.

Brannon Eagar, Chief Deputy Sheriff, requested approval to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding DPS Contract No 2014-156, and the Memorandum of Understanding will release funds designated for Apache County Sheriff's Office by the State, passed through DPS for strict enforcement of immigration, human smuggling, drug smuggling, gangs and employer sanction laws. **Mr. Weller moved approval, seconded by Mr. White.** Mr. Weller stated the County Attorney referenced a statute (in the backup material) that has to do with immigration and asked about an immigration lawsuit that named the County as a defendant. Mr. Young stated that there is a provision in the agreement that requires the County to enforce immigration laws and Apache County is one of many defendants in a lawsuit which is ongoing litigation. Mr. Weller, Chief Eagar and Mr. Young held a discussion regarding the details of issue. Motion passed.

Mr. Wengert on behalf of District I, requested approval of an Intergovernmental Agreement between Apache County and Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) for Safe Routes to School grant. **Mr. Weller moved approval, seconded by Mr. White.** Mr. Weller asked if the administration costs and burden of the reporting is done in St. Johns and if there is any administrative support in the Chinle staff. Mr. Wengert stated Malena Bazarro and the Chinle staff will handle the day to day administration. Mr. Weller asked if the County Attorney approved the agreement. Mr. Whiting stated it was reviewed and approved. Motion passed.

Ferrin Crosby, County Engineer, requested authorization to solicit bids for Magnesium Chloride to be applied on County Road 3140 as part of the RAC grant awarded earlier this year. **Mr. Weller moved approval, seconded by Mr. White.** Mr. Weller and Mr. Crosby held a discussion regarding the pricing of the product. Motion passed.

Lenora Fulton, County Recorder, requested approval to separate the Election Department and the Recorder's Office to become effective upon Board approval. Mrs. Fulton provided an overview of the activities since combining the two departments in January, and stated it has worked well to cross train employees in both departments but she realized after the ten months, it is difficult for an elected official to supervise and have direct contact within the election process with limited staff, and she feels an elected official should not have direct contact with the election process. Mrs. Fulton stated in the future if there is additional staffing and bigger offices, it would work well. **Mr. Weller moved to approve the separation, seconded by Mr. White.** Motion passed.

Angela Romero, Election Director, requested approval to combine the two part-time positions back to the permanent full time Executive Assistant position so there would be two full time employees in Elections. **Mr. Weller moved approval, seconded by Mr. White.** Motion passed.

Angela Romero, Election Director, requested approval, based on the recommendation of the Republican Party County Chairman, Delos Bond, determine vacancies exist in the office of precinct committeeman and appoint the following: Springerville Precinct: Jack Husted, St. Johns Precinct: Jay Platt and Richard Brower, Vernon Precinct: Michael Humphrey, Greer Precinct: Dean Wade and Betty Wade, Puerco East Precinct: Clarinda Yonnie. **Mr. Weller moved approval, seconded by Mr. White.** Motion passed.

Angela Romero, Election Director, requested authorization to cancel the School District Elections for the McNary Elementary School District and appoint Patricia Maxwell for one of the two existing Two Year Terms Chinle NE AZ Technical Institute of Vocational Education and appoint Anderson Jones for a Four Year Term. **Mr. Weller moved approval, seconded by Mr. White.** Motion passed.

Angela Romero, Election Director, presented notification of the Governor's Proclamation of the November 4, 2014 General Election. No action was needed or taken.

GENERAL ELECTION 2014

WHEREAS, Article 7, Section 11, of the Constitution of the State of Arizona provides that there shall be a general election of Representatives in Congress, and of State, County and precinct officers on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of the first even numbered year in which Arizona is admitted to Statehood and biennially thereafter; and

WHEREAS, Article 6, Section 38, of the Constitution of the State of Arizona, provides that the name of any justice or judge of the Supreme Court or an intermediate appellate court, and any judge of the superior court except for judges of the superior court in counties having a population of less than two hundred fifty thousand persons, according to the United States census, whose declaration of desire to be retained in office has been filed in the office of the Secretary of State and certified to the several Board of Supervisors, shall be placed on the appropriate official ballot at the next regular general election under nonpartisan designation; and

WHEREAS, Article 4, Part 1, Section 1 (10), of the Constitution of the State of Arizona, provides that when any Initiative or Referendum petition or any measure referred to the people by the Legislature shall be filed, in accordance with this section, with the Secretary of State, who shall cause to be printed on the official ballot at the next regular election the title and number of such measure, together with the words "Yes" and "No" in such manner that the electors may express at the polls their approval or disapproval of the measure; and

WHEREAS, Section 16-214, Arizona Revised Statutes, provides that at least thirty days before a general election, the Governor shall issue a proclamation containing a statement of the time of election, the offices to be filled, and shall transmit a copy of the election proclamation to the officer in charge of elections of the several counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Janice K. Brewer, Governor of the State of Arizona, do hereby proclaim the

To be held in the form prescribed by law on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November 2014, which shall be Tuesday, November 4, 2014, for the election of the following officials: nine United States Representatives in Congress, one Governor, one Secretary of State, one Attorney General, one State Treasurer, one Superintendent of Public Instruction, one State Mine Inspector, two Corporation Commissioners, thirty State Senators, sixty State Representatives, two Arizona Supreme Court Justices, five Judges of the Arizona Court of Appeals Division One, and one Judge of the Arizona Court of Appeals Division Two;

And for each of the counties of the State, as prescribed by law, such county officers, judges, justices of the peace, constables, and school district and community college governing boards, as may be applicable in each such county;

And to afford an opportunity for the qualified electors of the State of Arizona to vote upon any referred and initiated measures or constitutional amendments that are submitted in the form prescribed by the law.

Chairman White stated he would not be able to attend and gave his Proxy to Mr. Weller. No action was needed.

Chairman White opened the floor for the call to the public.

Lorraine Vaught, a resident of Vernon, Arizona stated she appreciated Chairman White and Supervisors Weller for being in person at the meeting today. Ms. Vaught stated she was here four weeks ago and questioned why a notice had not been put in the paper or sent out informing the tax payers affected, that 1.3 million in taxes had been abated, which the minutes of August 4th reflect. Mrs. Vaught stated after that August 4th meeting, she was approached and was told there was new software programs being installed within the next two weeks, and it's now been four weeks. Ms. Vaught stated she was told the information about the abatement was on the website but not everyone has access to a computer and the majority of the taxpayers are left in the dark. Mrs. Vaught stated she just received her tax statement 5 days late that was mailed on September 30th and is due October 1st and delinquent on November 1st or will have a late fee of 16% per year. Ms. Vaught stated her tax bill is very confusing; she understands the new software issues but the general public doesn't and again taxpayer are left in the dark and confused. Ms. Vaught asked for a better line of communication between the Treasurer's Office and the public.

George Walsh, a resident of Vernon, Arizona stated he wanted to address Item #8 because there was no motion to table the item he thinks the Board should revisit the item because you cant table an item without a motion and vote. Mr. Walsh stated that in regard to the appeal the Board heard earlier, they should listen to the explanation given by the Assessor's Office on agriculture use because it opened up a can of worms because agriculture use defined by the assessor is difference than agriculture use defined by Planning and Zoning.

Mr. Weller moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. White. Motion passed.

ARIZONA MUTUAL AID COMPACT

This Compact is made and entered into by and among the signatory political jurisdictions within the State of Arizona and the Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs.

Recitals

WHEREAS, one or more parties to this Compact may find it necessary to utilize all of their own resources to cope with emergencies and may require the assistance of another party or other parties; and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable that all resources of political subdivisions, municipal corporations, tribes and other public agencies be made available to respond to such emergencies; and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable that each of the parties hereto should assist one another when such emergency occurs by providing such resources as are available and needed including, but not limited to, fire, police, medical and health, environmental, communication, and transportation services to cope with the problems of response and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable that a compact be executed for the interchange of such mutual aid; and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable to utilize this agreement in exercising adopted emergency plans; and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the manner of financing of such cooperative undertakings be resolved in advance of such emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between each and all of the signatories hereto as follows:

COMPACT

1. Purpose.

The purpose of this Compact is to define for the participating parties the emergency management terms and procedures which will be used among participating parties for dispatching mutual aid assistance to any affected area in accordance with local ordinances, resolutions, emergency plans or agreements. Contracting authority for political subdivisions of Arizona for this Compact is based upon A.R.S. § 26-308 which provides that each county and incorporated city and town of the state may appropriate and expend funds, make contracts and obtain and distribute equipment, materials and supplies for emergency management purposes. Tribal contracting authority will be in accordance with each Tribe's laws. Special District authority will be in accordance with their respective laws. Public education district authority is based on A.R.S. § 15-342(13) and A.R.S. § 11-952. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance the laws of the State of Arizona.

2. Scope.

The Scope of this Compact is to (1) provide the procedures to notify the Providing Parties of the need for emergency assistance; (2) to identify available resources; and, (3) to provide a mechanism for compensation for resources.

3. Definitions.

- **Automatic Mutual Aid** means the automatic dispatch and response of requested resources without incident specific approvals. These agreements are usually basic contracts; some may be informal accords.
- **Backfill** means replacement of the Requesting Party's personnel who perform the regular duties of other personnel while they are performing eligible emergency work.
- **Compact** means this document, the Arizona Mutual Aid Compact (AZMAC).
- **Director** is the Director of the Department of Emergency and Military Affairs (DEMA).
- **Emergency or Emergencies** means any disaster, emergency, or contingency situation which requires a collaborative effort among multiple Jurisdictions.
- **Exercise** is the exercising of adopted emergency plans utilizing the Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP)
- **Jurisdiction** means an entity, including Political Subdivisions and tribal governments, which (1) has the authority to act, within a defined geographical area especially in times of emergency and (2) is a party to this Compact.

- **Local Mutual Aid** are agreements between neighboring jurisdictions or organizations that involve a formal request for assistance and generally cover a larger geographic area than automatic mutual aid.
- **Political Subdivision** means any county, incorporated city or town, fire district, or public education district, irrigation, power, electrical, agricultural improvement, drainage, and flood control districts, and other tax levying public improvement districts.
- **Providing Party** means the Jurisdiction providing aid in the event of an emergency.
- **Requesting Party** means the Jurisdiction requesting aid in the event of an Emergency.
- **Self-deployed** means to respond to an emergency without being requested by the Requesting Party.

4. **Guiding Policy.**

- Arizona Revised Statute (A.R.S.), Title 26, Military Affairs and Emergency Management.
- Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.), Title 8, Emergency and Military Affairs.
- National Incident Management System (NIMS), 2008

5. **Procedures for Requesting Assistance.**

A Requesting Party which needs assistance in excess of its own resources and existing automatic mutual aid or local mutual aid due to an emergency is authorized to request assistance from any party to this Compact. However, when making such requests, consideration shall be given to, and requests made, based on, but not limited to, the geographical proximity of other jurisdictions with that of the jurisdiction requesting assistance. All requests for assistance from the State must be coordinated through the Requesting Party's county emergency operations center, or tribal emergency operations center (whichever is applicable).

Requests should specify what the emergency is, what resources are needed and the estimated period of time during which such mutual aid shall be required, if known. Please use the Resource Request form provided in Appendix A.

6. **Providing Party's Assessment of Availability of Resources and Ability to Render Assistance.**

Subject to the terms of this Compact, the Providing Party shall make reasonable efforts to assist the Requesting Party. In all instances, the Providing Party shall render such mutual aid as it is able to provide consistent with its own service needs at the time, taking into

consideration the Providing Party's existing commitments within its own jurisdiction. The Providing Party shall be the sole judge of what mutual aid it has available to furnish to the Requesting Party pursuant to this Compact.

7. Implementation Plan.

Each party should develop an emergency operations plan that includes a process to provide for the effective mobilization of its resources, both public and private, including acceptance of mutual aid to provide or receive assistance under this Compact.

8. Contact List.

Each Party shall develop a contact list as outlined in Appendix B, which shall be provided to the Director for distribution to all other parties to this Compact.

9. Reimbursement Procedures between Parties.

If the Providing Party desires reimbursement for the assistance they are providing, the Requesting Party shall reimburse the Providing Party for all costs incurred in the mutual assistance, whether an incident has been declared an emergency or not. The Providing Party must declare its intent to seek reimbursement as part of their response to the Requesting Party's request for assistance (see Appendix A: Resource Request forms). The Providing Party and the Requesting party shall agree upon allowable costs for mutual assistance prior to the dispatch of any mutual assistance resources. Unless otherwise negotiated by the parties involved, the parties may reference the state allowable costs as defined in A.A.C. Title 8 (as may be amended from time to time). If the assistance is authorized and accepted, the Requesting Party shall reimburse the Providing Party all allowable costs of labor, equipment, and materials that have actually been expended during the execution of the mission assignment, after receipt of an itemized voucher and documentation is received.

If there has been a declaration of emergency from the Governor and/or President, the Requesting Party may be eligible for reimbursement for these mutual aid costs under the state or federal declaration of emergency. See item 10.

10. Reimbursement Procedures from the State.

If the Governor and/or President have declared an emergency, the Requesting Party can prepare an itemized voucher and documentation of all paid allowable costs including all the cost of the mutual aid resources reimbursed to any Providing Parties under this Compact, for submittal to the State for consideration for reimbursement in accordance with A.A.C. Title 8 (as may be amended from time to time). As per A.A.C. Title 8, R8-2-301, sub-parts 1, 12 & 15, only state agencies and political subdivisions are eligible to receive reimbursement under a Governor's Declaration. Any Tribal Nations as the Requesting Party would need to seek reimbursement under a Presidential Declaration. Any Tribal Nations as the Providing Party

would seek reimbursement from the Requesting Party as outlined in Item 9.

The state is not liable for any claim arising from an emergency for which the applicant receives funds from another source (A.A.C. Title 8, R8-2-312).

Self-deployed resources will not be reimbursed.

11. Personnel Compensation and Insurance.

The Requesting Party and the Providing Party shall be responsible for all compensation and insurance coverage of their respective employees and equipment.

12. Immunity.

The parties shall have such immunity as provided by applicable state, federal or tribal law.

13. Indemnification.

Each party (as "Indemnitor") agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the other party (as "Indemnitee") from and against any and all claims, losses, liability, costs, or expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Claims") arising out of bodily injury of any person (including death) or property damage, but only to the extent that such Claims which result in vicarious/derivative liability to the Indemnitee are caused by the act, omission, negligence, misconduct, or other fault of the Indemnitor, its officers, officials, agents, employees, or volunteers. This compact is between Governmental entities. Should a signatory to this agreement use a contractor for any purpose, said contractor would be required to abide by ADOA Risk Management insurance requirements which are attached as Appendix C.

14. Term.

This Compact shall be effective on the date it is recorded with the Secretary of State. Except as otherwise provided in this Compact, this Compact shall terminate ten years after the effective date. This Compact, upon mutual consent of the parties may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 10 years. Any modification or time extension of this Compact shall be by formal written amendment and executed by the parties hereto.

15. ADA.

Each party shall comply with applicable provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (Public Law 101-336, 42 United States Code. 12101-12213) and all applicable federal regulations under the Act, including 28 Code of Federal Regulation Parts 35 and 36.

16. Non-Discrimination.

To the extent of the law the Parties shall comply with Executive Order 2009-9, which mandates that all persons, regardless of race, color, religion, sex, age, or national origin not mentioned in Order shall have equal access to employment opportunities, and all other applicable state and Federal employment laws, rules, and regulations, including the Americans with Disabilities Act. Parties shall take affirmative action to ensure that applicants for employment and employees are not discriminated against due to race, creed, color, religion, sex, national origin or disability.

17. Compliance with Laws.

Each party shall comply with all federal, tribal, state and local laws, rules, regulations, standards and Executive Orders, as applicable, without limitation to those designated within this Compact. Any changes in the governing laws, rules and regulations during the terms of this Compact shall apply but do not require an amendment.

18. Worker's Compensation.

Each Party herein shall comply with the provisions of A.R.S §23-1022(E) by posting the public notice required. As provided for in A.R.S. §23-1022(D), an employee of a public agency who works under the jurisdiction or control of or within the jurisdictional boundaries of another public agency pursuant to a specific intergovernmental agreement or contract entered into between the public agencies is deemed to be an employee of both public agencies. However, the primary employer is solely liable for the payment of Workers' Compensation benefits. As such, each Party shall maintain Workers' Compensation insurance coverage on all of its own employees providing services pursuant to this agreement.

19. Insurance.

Each Party shall bear the risk of its own actions, as it does with all its operations, and shall determine for itself an appropriate level of insurance coverage and maintain such coverage. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as a waiver of any limitation on liability that may apply to a Party.

20. Non-appropriation.

Every payment obligation of the Parties under this Agreement is conditioned upon the availability of funds appropriated and allocated for the payment of such obligation. If funds are not appropriated, allocated and available or if the appropriation is changed by the legislature resulting in funds no longer being available for the continuance of this Agreement, this Agreement may be terminated by the Parties at the end of the period for which funds are

available. No liability shall accrue to the Party in the event this provision is exercised, and neither Party shall be obligated or liable for any future payments or for any damages as a result of termination under this paragraph.

21. No Third Party Beneficiaries.

Nothing in the provisions of this Compact is intended to create duties or obligations to or rights in third parties not parties to this Compact or affect the legal liability of any party to the Compact by imposing any standard of care different from the standard of care imposed by law.

22. Entire Compact.

This document constitutes the entire Compact between the parties pertaining to the subject matter hereof. This Compact shall not be modified, amended, altered or extended except through a written amendment signed by the parties and recorded with the Arizona Secretary of State or Tribal government as appropriate.

23. Jurisdiction.

Nothing in this Compact shall be construed as otherwise limiting or extending the legal jurisdiction of any party. Nothing in this Compact is intended to confer any rights or remedies to any person or entity that is not a party.

24. Conflict of Interest.

The requirements of A.R.S. § 38-511 apply to this Agreement. The Parties may cancel this Agreement, without penalty or further obligation, if any person significantly involved in initiating, negotiating, securing, drafting or creating this Agreement on behalf of the Party is, at any time while this Agreement or any extension is in effect, an employee, agent or consultant of Party with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement.

25. Supervision and Control.

Management of an emergency shall remain with the jurisdiction in which the emergency occurred. Supervision and control of Providing Parties' personnel and equipment shall be in accordance with National Incident Management System. The Requesting Party will be responsible for providing supplies and services, such as food, shelter, gasoline and oil, for on-site use of equipment and for the personnel providing assistance. All equipment and personnel used pursuant to this Compact shall be returned to the Providing Party upon being released by the Requesting Party or on demand of the Providing Party for such return.

26. Severability: Effect on Other Agreements.

It is expressly understood that this Compact shall not supplant existing agreements between some of the parties, which do provide for the exchange or furnishing of certain types of services on a compensated basis.

27. Severability.

If any provision of this Compact is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and enforceable to the full extent permitted by law.

28. Responsibility of the Department of Emergency and Military Affairs.

Nothing within this Compact limits or restricts the duties and obligations the State of Arizona may have to respond to the emergency of any party.

29. Effective Date.

This Compact shall become effective as to each party when adopted by resolution and executed by the governing body of the jurisdiction, and shall remain operative and effective as between each and every party that has heretofore or hereafter executed this Compact, until participation in this Compact is terminated by the party. The termination by one or more of the parties of its participation in this Compact shall not affect the operation of this Compact as between the other parties thereto. The Director shall identify on their website, with updates as needed, all parties signatory to this Compact.

30. Execution Procedure.

Execution of this Compact shall be as follows:

This Compact, which will be designated as "ARIZONA MUTUAL AID COMPACT," shall be executed in counterparts by the governing body of each party. Upon execution, the counterpart will be filed with the Secretary of State and the Tribal government as applicable and be provided to the Director. This Compact will be effective between all parties who execute this Compact even if it is not executed by all eligible jurisdictions.

31. Termination.

Termination of participation in this Compact may be effected by any party as follows:

Notice of termination will be given to the Director 20 days prior to termination.

Any party may, by resolution of its governing body, terminate its participation in this Compact and file a certified copy of such resolution with the Secretary of State or the Tribal government, with a copy to be provided to the Director.

The parties to this Compact understand and acknowledge that this Compact is subject

to cancellation by any party pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-511 or applicable Tribal law.

32. Dispute Resolution.

The Parties to this Agreement agree to resolve all disputes arising out of or relating to this Agreement through arbitration, after exhausting applicable administrative review, to the extent required by A.R.S. § 12-1518 except as may be required by other applicable statutes.

33. Record Retention

Pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 35-214 and 35-215, the Parties shall retain all records relating to this Agreement for a period of five years after completion of the Agreement. All records shall be subject to inspection and audit by the State of Arizona at reasonable times.

ARIZONA MUTUAL AID COMPACT (AZMAC) USE OF A CONTRACTOR

In addition, each signatory shall cause its contractor(s) and subcontractors, if any, to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the State of Arizona, any jurisdiction or agency issuing any permits for any work arising out of this Agreement, and their respective directors, officers, officials, agents, and employees (hereinafter referred to as "Indemnatee") from and against any and all claims, actions, liabilities, damages, losses, or expenses (including court costs, attorneys' fees, and costs of claim processing, investigation and litigation) (hereinafter referred to as "Claims") for bodily injury or personal injury (including death), or loss or damage to tangible or intangible property caused, or alleged to be caused, in whole or in part, by the negligent or willful acts or omissions of signatory's contractor or any of the directors, officers, agents, or employees or subcontractors of such contractor. This indemnity includes any claim or amount arising out of or recovered under the Workers' Compensation Law or arising out of the failure of such contractor to conform to any federal, state or local law, statute, ordinance, rule, regulation or court decree. It is the specific intention of the parties that the Indemnatee shall, in all instances, except for Claims arising solely from the negligent or willful acts or omissions of the Indemnatee, be indemnified by such contractor from and against any and all claims. It is agreed that such contractor will be responsible for primary loss investigation, defense and judgment costs where this indemnification is applicable."

Insurance Requirements for Governmental Parties:

None.

Insurance Requirements for Any Contractors Used by a Party to the Intergovernmental Agreement:

(Note: this applies only to Contractors used by a governmental entity, not to the governmental entity itself.) The insurance requirements herein are minimum requirements and in no way limit the indemnity covenants contained in the Intergovernmental Agreement. The State of Arizona in no way warrants that the minimum limits contained herein are sufficient to protect the governmental entity or Contractor from liabilities that might arise out of the performance of the work under this Contract by the Contractor, his agents, representatives, employees or subcontractors, and Contractor and the governmental entity are free to purchase additional insurance.

A. Minimum Scope and Limits of Insurance: Contractor shall provide coverage with limits of liability not less than those stated below.

1. Commercial General Liability – Occurrence Form

Policy shall include bodily injury, property damage, personal and advertising injury and broad form contractual liability.

- General Aggregate \$2,000,000
- Products – Completed Operations Aggregate \$1,000,000
- Personal and Advertising Injury \$1,000,000
- Damage to Rented Premises \$ 50,000
- Each Occurrence \$1,000,000

a. The policy shall be endorsed (Blanket Endorsements are not acceptable) to include the following additional insured language: “The State of Arizona, and its departments, agencies, boards, commissions, universities, officers, officials, agents, and employees shall be named as additional insureds with respect to liability arising out of the activities performed by or on behalf of the Contractor.” Such additional insured shall be covered to the full limits of liability purchased by the Contractor, even if those limits of liability are in excess of those required by this Contract.

(Note that the other governmental entity(ies) is/are also required to be additional insured(s) and they should supply the Contractor with their own list of persons to be insured.)

b. Policy shall contain a waiver of subrogation endorsement (Blanket Endorsements are not acceptable) in favor of the “State of Arizona, and its departments, agencies, boards, commissions, universities, officers, officials, agents, and employees” for losses arising from work performed by or on behalf of the Contractor.

2. Business Automobile Liability

Bodily Injury and Property Damage for any owned, hired, and/or non-owned vehicles used in the performance of this Contract.

- Combined Single Limit (CSL) \$1,000,000

a. The policy shall be endorsed (Blanket Endorsements are not acceptable) to include the following additional insured language: “The State of Arizona, and its departments, agencies, boards, commissions, universities, officers, officials, agents, and employees shall be named as additional insureds with respect to liability arising

out of the activities performed by or on behalf of the Contractor, involving automobiles owned, leased, hired or borrowed by the Contractor". Such additional insured shall be covered to the full limits of liability purchased by the Contractor, even if those limits of liability are in excess of those required by this Contract.

- b. Policy shall contain a waiver of subrogation endorsement (Blanket Endorsements are not acceptable) in favor of the "State of Arizona, its departments, agencies, boards, commissions, universities and its officers, officials, agents, and employees" for losses arising from work performed by or on behalf of the Contractor.

(Note that the other governmental entity(ies) is/are also required to be additional insured(s) and they should supply the Contractor with their own list of persons to be insured.)

- c. Policy shall contain a severability of interest provision.

- a. Policy shall contain a waiver of subrogation endorsement (Blanket Endorsements are not acceptable) in favor of the "State of Arizona, its departments, agencies, boards, commissions, universities and its officers, officials, agents, and employees" for losses arising from work performed by or on behalf of the Contractor.
- b. This requirement shall not apply to: Separately, EACH contractor or subcontractor exempt under A.R.S. § 23-901, AND when such contractor or subcontractor executes the appropriate waiver (Sole Proprietor/Independent Contractor) form.

B. Additional Insurance Requirements: The policies are to contain, or be endorsed (Blanket Endorsements are not acceptable) to contain, the following provisions:

- 1. The Contractor's policies shall stipulate that the insurance afforded the Contractor shall be primary insurance and that any insurance carried by the Department, its agents, officials, employees or the State of Arizona shall be excess and not contributory insurance, as provided by A.R.S § 41-621 (E).

2. The Contractor's insurance shall apply separately to each insured against whom claim is made or suit is brought, except with respect to the limits of the insurer's liability. Coverage provided by the Contractor shall not be limited to the liability assumed under the indemnification provisions of its Contract with the other governmental entity(ies) party to the IGA.
- C. Notice of Cancellation: With the exception of (10) day notice of cancellation for non-payment of premium, any changes material to compliance with this contract in the insurance policies above shall require (30) days written notice to the State of Arizona. Such notice shall be sent directly to the Department and shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested.
- D. Acceptability of Insurers: Contractors insurance shall be placed with companies licensed in the State of Arizona. Insurers shall have an "A.M. Best" rating of not less than A- VII or duly authorized to transact Workers' Compensation insurance in the State of Arizona. The State of Arizona in no way warrants that the above-required minimum insurer rating is sufficient to protect the Contractor from potential insurer insolvency.
- E. Verification of Coverage: Contractor shall furnish the State of Arizona with certificates of insurance (ACORD form or equivalent approved by the State of Arizona) as required by this Contract. The certificates for each insurance policy are to be signed by an authorized representative.
- All certificates and endorsements (Blanket Endorsements are not acceptable) are to be received and approved by the State of Arizona before work commences. Each insurance policy required by this Contract must be in effect at or prior to commencement of work under this Contract and remain in effect for the duration of the project. Failure to maintain the insurance policies as required by this Contract, or to provide evidence of renewal, is a material breach of contract.
- All certificates required by this Contract shall be sent directly to the Department. The State of Arizona project/contract number and project description are to be noted on the certificate of insurance. The State of Arizona reserves the right to require complete, certified copies of all insurance policies required by this Contract at any time.
- F. Subcontractors: Contractor's certificate(s) shall include all subcontractors as insureds under its policies or Contractor shall furnish to the State of Arizona separate certificates for each subcontractor. All coverages for subcontractors shall be subject to the minimum requirements identified above.

- G. Approval: Any modification or variation from the *insurance requirements* in any Intergovernmental Agreement must have prior approval from the State of Arizona Department of Administration, Risk Management Division, whose decision shall be final. Such action will not require a formal contract amendment, but may be made by administrative action.
- H. Exceptions: In the event the Contractor or sub-contractor(s) is/are a public entity, then the Insurance Requirements shall not apply. Such public entity shall provide a Certificate of Self-Insurance. If the contractor or sub-contractor(s) is/are a State of Arizona agency, board, commission, or university then none of the above shall apply.
