### Widow/Widower

#### Qualifications:

Applicant must be an owner of the property and a resident of Arizona. If a part owner a percentage of exemption may apply.

A “Certified” or “Government Use” **death certificate for the deceased spouse must be recorded** with the Apache County Recorder’s Office.

### Income Reporting Requirements:

All income from the **previous calendar year** must be reported, although not all income is used to calculate total income.

State-set total income limit for a household with no children under age 18 is \$39,865.

State-set total income limit for a household with children under 18 is \$47,826.

Applicant's total household income, cannot exceed the State of Arizona’s maximum income limit.

Applicant’s total assessed value for all properties owned cannot exceed the State of Arizona’s 2026 maximum assessment limit of \$36,454.



### Disability Qualifications:

Applicant must be an owner of the property and a resident of Arizona.

Applicate must be medically certified **100% totally & permanently disabled**.

The completed AZ DOR Certificate of Disability form DOR82514B is required.

### Disabled Veterans Qualifications:

Applicant must be an owner of the property and a resident of Arizona. If a part owner a percentage of exemption may apply.

Veterans with a disability exemption **must** provide their VA Disability Letter, that states their **Overall Combined Service Rating**. The Exemption percentage amount would be equal to the percentage of disability.

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
