



# **TRUTH IN TAXATION HEARING NOTICE OF TAX INCREASE**

In compliance with section 42-17107, Arizona Revised Statutes, Apache County is notifying its property taxpayers of Apache County's intention to raise its primary property taxes over last year's level. Apache County is proposing an increase in primary property taxes of \$72,736 or 2.00%.

For example, the proposed tax increase will cause Apache County's primary property taxes on a \$100,000 home to be \$79.64. Without the proposed tax increase, the total taxes that would be owed on a \$100,000 home would have been \$78.08.

This proposed increase is exclusive of increased primary property taxes received from new construction. The increase is also exclusive of any changes that may occur from property tax levies for voter approved bonded indebtedness or budget and tax overrides.
