PSSA TESTING SCHEDULE

Lake-Noxen students in grade 3 through 6 will participate in Pennsylvania System of School Assessment testing. All students will take the English/Language Arts and Math tests while grade 5 students will also take the Science tests. Please ensure that your child is in school during testing dates, avoid tardiness and early dismissals. PSSA testing dates are as follows:

English/Language Arts April 21 through April 24
Math and Science April 28 through May 1

Student accounts can be set up online on the SchoolCafe' website. SchoolCafe' is accessible under the FOOD SERVICE tab on the L-L website. You are able to set up automatic payments and receive alerts.

If sending money to pay for student meals into school, please send checks (payable to LLSLD) or cash in an envelope labeled "Cafe". Remember to include student's name and student ID number on the envelope. Please remind students to give all money to their homeroom teacher in the morning. Students should not give money directly to the cafeteria employees.
