### **NOTICE OF WEAPON INCIDENT IN A SINGLE SCHOOL BUILDING**

*In Accordance with Act 44 of 2025, Section 1303.2-A of the School Code*

January 21, 2026

Dear Lake-Noxen Parents/Guardians and Staff,

This letter provides notice to parents and guardians of students attending and employees assigned to Lake-Noxen Elementary School of an incident involving a weapon on the Lake-Noxen school grounds at approximately 11:30 a.m. on January 20, 2026.

The building administration took appropriate action upon notification and consequences were addressed in accordance with District policies and procedures.

Please be assured that the safety of our students and staff remains our highest priority. Additional steps will be taken to ensure the continued security of our school community, if appropriate. At this point, there does not appear to be any imminent threat of harm to our school community remaining.

We would kindly ask that you continue to partner with us in creating a safe learning environment for all students and staff by reinforcing with your children that weapons of any kind are neither appropriate nor permitted in our schools or on school property, as outlined in District policies.

Our school is committed to supporting the well-being of all students. We understand that some members of our school community may have been affected by this recent event. Students who feel impacted in any way are encouraged to access the counseling staff and other support personnel available to them.
