From Principal Klopp: Main Entrance Construction Update

I want to share a quick update so everyone understands the timeline. The project has moved a little slower than we originally hoped, mainly due to delays in receiving the replacement doors and windows from the supplier. Unfortunately, that part is out of our hands, but we are staying in close contact with the contractor and moving forward as materials arrive.

In the meantime, our students have done a great job adjusting. They are learning to use the side stairwells during the school day, as the main entrance stairwells will be reserved for evacuations and afternoon dismissals moving forward. We appreciate everyone's patience and flexibility as we work through these improvements to make our building safer and more secure for the long term.

PSSA Testing Schedule

The Academic Fair/Art Show Committee funded the spring of 2025, school wide field trip to the Dietrich Theatre from raffle donations and ticket purchases.




Title 1's annual Literacy Night took place on February 11th. Students in grades K-3 enjoyed hands-on, Candyland themed literacy activities.
