The Career Frontier Program, sponsored by The Valley Health System and The Valley Hospital, has been in existence for 20 years. The program is a volunteer internship (unpaid) that includes a placement in a clinical area, attendance at presentations (given by Valley Health professionals), tours and a variety of learning experiences. This is not a shadowing program. Each student/volunteer will be assigned a mentor, who will be responsible for orientating the student through the program.

Orientation will be Wednesday, July 1. The program will begin on Monday, July 6 and conclude on Thursday, July 30. The program will run for four days a week (Monday-Thursday), from 8:30am-2:00pm.
