Dear St. Rita Parents and Guardians,

This coming **Tuesday, November 11**, school will be closed for Veterans Day as we honor those who have so bravely served our country. Our country is founded on the principles of freedom, justice, and liberty for all. Our students will honor our veterans at the 9:00 A.M. Mass on **Friday, November 7**. Please join us. Our nation's soldiers serve every

day to protect our country and its ideals. As a way of honoring our veterans, please have your child take some time on Veterans Day, to remember and thank those who sacrifice their lives to achieve peace and democracy in our country. Have your child make a phone call or pay a visit to someone they know (grandpa, grandma, aunt, uncle, neighbor, or friend) who is currently serving or has served in the armed forces. All they need to do is say thank you.

On Monday, November 10, Legacy Photos will take class and club photos. All students must be in the proper school uniform. No GYM uniforms.

On Sunday, November 16, St. Rita School will host an Open House in conjunction with Discover Catholic Schools Week. From 12:30-2:00 P.M., the school will be open for prospective students and their families. Since our current families are the best ambassadors for our school, please invite your friends, neighbors, and family members to take advantage of this opportunity to tour St. Rita School. Individualized tours by our Crusader Club members and the opportunity to speak directly with our dedicated and supportive faculty will allow our visitors to hear about our strong academic programs and extracurricular offerings. The first trimester ends on **November 21st**. Report cards will be issued on Tuesday, December 2. Parents of students in grades 4-8 have access to their child's grades. Please take the time over the next few days to look at your child's grades along with your child, and remind him/her about his/her responsibility when it comes to completing and turning in work, and making up any missed work or tests. Now is the time for your child to arrange extra help sessions if they are struggling. Do not ask your child's teacher for any extra credit work if your child is not completing their assigned work.

If your child is absent, please notify the office, as well as the teacher, with the reason for the absence with their full name. As winter is approaching and student illnesses become more prevalent, and families planning vacations not coinciding with days off, it is important that all parents and students keep the following in mind regarding taking a day off from school: for each day a student is absent from school, he/she misses out on 6 ½ hours of instructional time that cannot be made up. CT law defines truancy as a child between the ages of 5 and 18 who has 4 unexcused absences from school in one month or 10 unexcused absences in one school year. If a student reaches the threshold listed above, parents will be notified.

For the Catholic Church, November is the traditional month for remembering those who have died. Praying for the dead is one of the Spiritual Works of Mercy, so during November, we pray in a particular way for those we love and to whom we owe so much – the deceased

members of our families, our benefactors, and our alumni. Please join us for Mass on **Friday, November 21**, at 9:00 A.M. which is being offered for all the deceased members of our St. Rita School community. Thank you for joining us in prayer now and throughout the year.



Nurse's Corner

Hamden Public Schools and St. Rita School will now be following the new respiratory virus guidelines set forth by the CDC and our local health department.

COVID will now fall into the same category as the flu and RSV

as a respiratory virus.

If your child develops symptoms of a respiratory virus (cough, fever, runny nose, congestion, fatigue), they should stay home until they are fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication and their symptoms are improving. They can return to school and we would encourage the use of a mask for 5 days.

Reminder:

Required physicals for PreK , Kindergarten and Grade 7:

Please remember to send in your child's physical if they are entering grade 7, PreK, and/or Kindergarten .These are required for entry into school in August.

Medication reminder:


Please do not send medication into school with your child. This includes any Over The Counter medication (Advil, Tylenol, Midol, cold medicine, allergy medicine, etc). Medication that needs to be taken during school hours must be brought into school by an adult along with a medication order from the physician.

If you wish to have cough drops available to your child please send them into school with a note. The nurse will keep them in her office and administer them to your child as needed.
