Dear West Oso ISD Families,

We are grateful to have your child attend West Oso ISD as a transfer student. As we near the end of the first nine weeks, we want to remind you of important guidelines in place to ensure that the 2025–2026 school year is a successful one.

In order to continue meeting all transfer requirements, we ask that you please review the information below with your student. At West Oso ISD, we are committed to partnering with families to ensure every student succeeds. We rely on your continued support in reinforcing the expectations outlined by West Oso ISD regarding **attendance, behavior, and academic performance**. Students who meet these expectations will be **automatically approved for enrollment** in subsequent years.

### Transfer Expectations:

To maintain transfer status, students must:

- Maintain at least **90% attendance** throughout the school year.
- Keep **passing grades** in all classes.
- Have **fewer than 15 tardies or early pick-ups**.
- Demonstrate **satisfactory conduct** in the classroom, on campus, and at all school-related events.

### Transfers May Be Revoked Mid-Year For:


- **Academic:** Failure to maintain passing grades after a probationary period.
- **Attendance:** Falling below the 90% attendance requirement under Texas compulsory attendance law after a probationary period.
- **Discipline:**
  - Receiving **three or more office referrals** in a semester.
  - Any assignment to **DAEP, suspension, or expulsion**.
- **Other:** Failure to comply with the terms of an individualized transfer contract.

Students with academic, attendance, or behavior concerns will be placed on a **probationary contract** for the 2025–2026 school year. A committee will review all students on probationary status in the spring to determine eligibility for enrollment for the 2026–2027 school year.

Please know that campus administration and staff are here to support your student. Open communication is key to the success of this partnership. We encourage you to reach out with any questions or concerns. Together, we can ensure your student has a successful school year.
