P-TECH Early College High School Admission Procedures

Thank you for your interest in the West Oso P-TECH Early College High School. Before completing the enclosed application, we request that you carefully consider the information below to determine if this program is the most suitable education experience for you/your child.

West Oso P-TECH Early College High School's primary focus is on providing students from underrepresented backgrounds (i.e. at-risk, low income and/or first-generation college attendees) the opportunity to earn up to 60 college credits free of charge while attending high school. As a P-TECH Early College campus, we offer students the opportunity to engage in work-based learning at every grade level.

Application Criteria

Eligibility

- Classified as a first year Grade 9 student.
- Identified as at-risk, English Language Learner, first generation to attend college, low socio-economic, and or an underrepresented student.
- Display the potential for college-level work while in middle school.
- Committed to education.

Application Process

1. Student and parent express a desire to pursue P-TECH Early College by attending mandatory West Oso P-TECH Early College Information Meeting/Orientation.
2. Administrator and/or counselor conduct an in-depth orientation for both the parents and students. This orientation will cover the structure, goals, intent, and standard expectations of West Oso ISD and West Oso P-TECH Early College High School.
3. Student and parent/guardian will complete the P-TECH Early College High School: answering designated questions and submit application in person to West Oso Junior High School Counseling Department or West Oso High School on or before the deadline.
4. Review of the P-TECH Early College application is done blindly with all identifying information hidden from the selection committee. The selection committee consists of Central Administration, Campus Administration, Counselors, and Teachers of West Oso P-TECH Early College High School and West Oso Junior High.
5. Complete applications that meet the selection criteria are placed in a lottery pool in which students are chosen to become the future P-TECH Early College High School cohort by random computerized drawing.
6. Selected applicants and their parents/guardians are notified through official mail two weeks following the lottery drawing.
7. Parents/guardians and students have two weeks to return the West Oso P-TECH Early College High School commitment form to West Oso Junior High School Counseling Department of their acceptance of the invitation to become a member of the P-TECH Early College High School.
