High School Students and Parents/Guardians,

Concurrent enrollment is a program that allows high school students to enroll in college courses while still attending high school. This program offers students the opportunity to earn both high school and college credit simultaneously.

**The below information DOES NOT apply to students participating in Warren Tech** (unless the student plans to take concurrent enrollment courses through Addenbrooke **IN ADDITION** to their Warren Tech program, which is rarely recommended).

**If you do not plan to participate in the Concurrent Enrollment program during the 2026-2027 school year, you may disregard this message.**

For those interested in pursuing concurrent enrollment at ACA, please read on. Some necessary action items are included below.

### **Concurrent Enrollment Qualifications**

This is just a reminder that **ALL** of the below guidelines must be met for Addenbrooke students to qualify for the Concurrent Enrollment program.

- In Grade 10, 11, or 12 During the Upcoming 2026-2027 School Year
  - Community Member Recommendation\*
  - Grades of A/B in All High School Classes During the Most Recent Semester
  - Grades of C or Above in All Previous College (Concurrent Enrollment) Classes
  - Accuplacer Completed with Qualifying Scores (for RRCC & ACC courses only)\*
  - Teacher Recommendations (gathered by Ms. Michelsen - no action required on your part)\*
  - Necessary Paperwork Completed by Designated Due Dates (more info to come on this)
- 
- Meeting with Ms. Michelsen **no later than Friday, April 17th** (sign up for a slot [here](#)).

*\*Applies only to students that are new to or re-entering the Concurrent Enrollment program*

These parameters are in place to ensure every student has the opportunity for success during their high school years at the level that best suits their needs.

### **Partner Colleges**

Students may choose to take classes through the following colleges:

- [CU Denver \(CU Succeed Program\)](#)
  - Available on the Addenbrooke campus only
  - Recommended for students in grades 10, 11, and 12
  - No cost to the student
- [Arapahoe Community College \(ACC\)](#)
  - In-seat courses on the college campus
  - Recommended for students in grades 11 or 12
  - Tuition for in-seat courses is paid for by Addenbrooke. The cost of books and fees are the responsibility of the student.
- [Colorado Christian University \(CCU\)](#)

- Online options only
- Recommended for students in grades 11 or 12
- Tuition is paid for by Addenbrooke. The cost of books and fees are the responsibility of the student.
- [Red Rocks Community College \(RRCC\)](#)
  - In-seat courses on the college campus
  - Recommended for students in grades 11 or 12
  - Tuition for in-seat courses is paid for by Addenbrooke. The cost of books and fees are the responsibility of the student.

College classes taught on the high school campus are offered through CU Denver and are taught by approved Addenbrooke staff.

### **Accuplacer** (*new Concurrent Enrollment students only*)

**If you are new to the Concurrent Enrollment program and plan to attend Red Rocks or ACC and have not yet taken the Accuplacer test, it is important to do so at your earliest convenience. This is NOT required for CU Denver or CCU students.**

You must contact [RRCC](#) or [ACC](#) directly to set up this assessment.

Once you have completed the test, please email your results to [kmichelsen2@addenbrooke.org](mailto:kmichelsen2@addenbrooke.org), so I can let you know which college classes you qualify for. Your Accuplacer results ARE NOT shared with Addenbrooke by RRCC or ACC, so it is important you send them to Ms. Michelsen.

If I do not get Accuplacer scores from you, I will assume you are not participating in concurrent enrollment classes next year.

### **Course Contract** (*all Concurrent Enrollment students*)

All concurrent enrollment students must complete the [Course Contract](#) **no later than Thursday, April 30th**. Please read it over carefully. Once completed, email the form to [kmichelsen2@addenbrooke.org](mailto:kmichelsen2@addenbrooke.org).

### **Your Off-campus Schedule**

Juniors and Seniors (2026-2027)...

**If you are taking off-site courses directly through ACC, CCU, or RRCC, please send a screenshot of your schedule** to [kmichelsen2@addenbrooke.org](mailto:kmichelsen2@addenbrooke.org). This will ensure your concurrent enrollment schedule coincides well with the classes you will be taking at Addenbrooke.

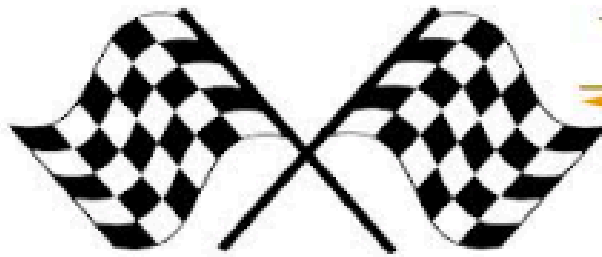

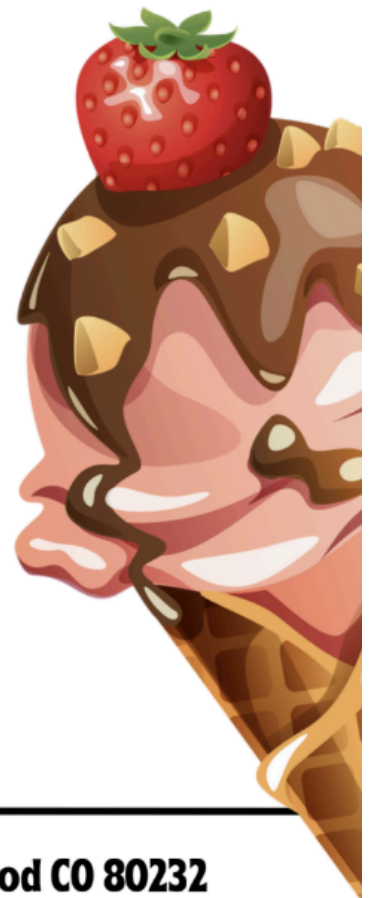
