District Accountability Committee (DAC): Ric reported that they did not have enough information to comment on most schools.

School Performance Framework (SPF): Mrs. Clary reported that SPF in K-8 increased from 65% to 71.5%. The HS scores were at 65%. Most categories meet standards. The results indicated that the areas we need to work on are:

Develop a reading plan. Use CKLA across K-8.

Increase attention to Gifted and Talented students.

Focus on gaps with minority students and students with disabilities.

Support teachers to come up with improvement strategies.

Instructional Priorities: Teachers need to implement more writing instruction in math and science due to CMAS writing-heavy structure. CUBES helps, but vocabulary gaps persist. Maintain foundational fluency using Mad Minute. Kelly Heckman is now the K-12 ELL teacher coach.

UIP: We remain in "Performance category; K-5 improved from SPF 33% to 70%; HS at 65. UIP priorities focus on gifted/ALP outcomes, K-8 literacy (CKLA fidelity, vocabulary, writing), multilingual learner supports, and data-driven culture (MAPS/CMAS.)

Safety: Security posture reaffirmed (external audit completed 18 mos ago; drills include non-classroom scenarios). Maintain high-level comms without sensitive detail; no-phone policy praised. Leadership balances reassurance with operational security (limited details).

Annual Survey: We will continue to do the "triple threat" (Robo call, science fair reminder distribution, and last-day assembly distribution. We will also distribute reminders in both car lines.

SAC Participation: Expand SAC participation via targeted invites (especially recent board applicants), PAC coordination, and event outreach, recruit SAC secretary. Personally invite parents who participate in school activities.

Action Items: Ric will obtain emails from Board President; send invitations to five board applicants.

Libby: Coordinate SAC overview at PACS meeting.
