The second section will help guide the development of goals for the strategic plan, focusing on three key areas: Academic Excellence, Optimize Resources, and Community Engagement and Partnership (a separate survey will cover Culture and Climate). Your input in both sections reflects the needs and priorities of our students, families, and community.

IPHONE USERS: To scan a QR code with your iPhone, open the default Camera app, point it at the QR code, and tap the yellow link or notification banner that pops up on the screen. You do not need to download any extra apps.
