Ganado Unified School District is proud to offer this service to our students. It is our goal to ensure that students and parents understand our policies and procedures, along with behavior expectation, so that students can be successful bus riders. However, this is a privilege which can be revoked if a student's behavior jeopardizes his/her and/or the safety of others. If a student loses this privilege, then it becomes the parent's responsibility to transport the student to and from school.

Here are a few key points we would like to highlight that can also be found in our GUSD Student Handbook.

- **Right-Side Student Drop-Off** the school buses will be stopping on both sides of major highways, students are expected to not cross major highways and enter and exits school buses at the designated bus stops of the same of the highway as their residence.
- **For students in Pre-K—5th grade it IS A REQUIREMENT** to have a guardian or designated responsible adult at the bus for pick up. If no parent or guardian is available for pick-up, then the student will be transported back to the Transportation Department.
- **Once students are on the bus, they are not allowed to get off the bus until they reach their designated bus stop, unless prior arrangements were approved through the Transportation.**
- **Remain seated properly at all times.**
