1. Superintendent/ Principal Report:

a.) Current enrollment 129, ADM 1/2 = 121 and District happenings:

Ms. Romero reported: During parent teacher conferences before Spring Break, parents took a school survey and the overall score was an outstanding 99% , state testing has begun, field trips have begun, baseball team and girls basketball games have begun , some discipline problems here and there, preparing for next school year, school collected \$614. 40 coins for tree donation in memory for Danny Fish. Mrs. Gonzales read Energy Bus Book to students in grades K-5 to start penny drive , Earth Day coming up, will have some students help plant the tree will also be getting a stone that reads tree planted in memory of Danny Fish, Ms. Romero presented a plaque sent by Living Tribute Organization to the Fish family on behalf of Little Red family, 100 trees will be planted in the Arizona National Forest in honor of Danny Fish.

Mrs. Gonzales commented that it was a joyful project to work with the classrooms, seeing excitement on kid's faces and creating change. Mr. R. Fish thanked Little Red on behalf of his family for recognizing Danny Fish.
