## **OLD TESTAMENT PROPHECY**

***Isaiah 9:2-7***

The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shined. You have multiplied the nation; you have increased its joy; they rejoice before you as with joy at the harvest, as they are glad when they divide the spoil. For the yoke of his burden, and the staff for his shoulder, the rod of his oppressor, you have broken as on the day of Midian. For every boot of the tramping warrior in battle tumult and every garment rolled in blood will be burned as fuel for the fire. For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

## **THE ANGEL APPEARS TO MARY**

**P** This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about:

**(Women):** Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be with child through the Holy Spirit.

**(Men):** Because Joseph her husband, was a righteous man and did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly.

**(Women):** But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said,

**(Men):** Joseph son, of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.

**(Women):** She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins. All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet. The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel – which means God with us.

(Men): When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife. But he had no union with her until she gave birth to a son. And he gave him the name Jesus.
