Sunday, June 28 @3:30pm**

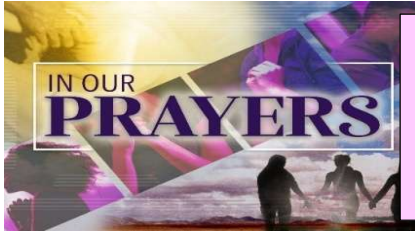
