MITES SUNDAY

It is the first Sunday of the month and that means we are collecting Mites offerings for LWML. Our featured grant this month is once again a national grant voted on in 2025 in Omaha. This grant is a \$100,000 grant for Lutheran Braille Workers, who are committed to providing Christian materials in braille and specialized large print worldwide at no cost. With part of this money, they will establish five new Ministry Production Centers in the United States. This will allow them to produce and freely distribute approximately 10,000 additional volumes of Bibles and other Christian materials. They will also purchase specialized paper, card stock, braille plates, and equipment. Thank you for your faithful support of the Mites ministry.
