Safety and Security

The safety and well-being of our students and staff, both physically and emotionally, remain a top priority at MVED.

In 2023, the Minnesota Legislature updated school emergency drill requirements. As part of these state mandates, schools are required to hold five lockdown drills, 5 fire drills, and 1 tornado drill throughout the year. So far this school year, we have completed: Two fire drills and one lockdown drill.

We will continue to work closely with Officer Hughes, St. Peter's School Resource Officer, to ensure our drills and safety procedures are effective and supportive for everyone involved.

Tidbits & Reminders

As we move into the winter months, please make sure students are dressed appropriately for the changing weather. Our elementary students go outside for both recess and physical education, so hats, gloves, and warm jackets are important.

This also applies to our secondary students who walk home or spend time outside after school. If your family needs assistance with winter clothing, please don't hesitate to reach out — we're happy to help gather what's needed.

Students (K-12th grade) have completed the first round of FastBridge testing which is used as universal screening and progress monitoring for both Math and Reading. The goal is to provide educators with data to identify students who need extra support, track their growth, and make informed instructional decisions from year to year.

The team has been working on getting our new sensory room up and running soon! This is exciting for the staff because it will provide another space for students to utilize!
