## Registration Information for 2026-2027 School Year

Fees may be subject to change until official opening of registration in January.

### **Tuition**                      **Fees**

- One Child:        \$7,400        \$400.00
- Two Children:   \$14,600       \$500.00
- Three Children: \$21,900       \$600.00
- Four Children:   \$29,200       \$700.00
- \$22 application fee per child for new families
- The 5th child & additional children are FREE, within the same household.

One time fee of \$100 for graduating 8th graders are payable with the registration fee.

(Discount for multiple children does not include a child in the Preschool.)

### **Additional Funding**

Instead of higher tuition, we ask for these financial commitments to be met by June 1st.

**Volunteer Commitment:** Volunteer 25 hours to support teachers, help at school and PTG events, or other needs for the school from home or after school hours. As an alternative you may pay a fee of \$500 in lieu of hours.

**Jogathon:** Raise or pay \$150 towards our Jogathon. We supply an online fundraising software to help meet that goal.

**Gala:** Purchase 2 tickets for \$200 to attend our annual Gala.

**Golf Tournament:** Buy or sell \$100 worth of chances in our Golf Ball Drop to win \$2000 and donate \$25 toward raffle & auction items. Parents, friends and extended families are invited to play in the tournament to raise additional dollars for the school.

**Scrip:** New families are asked to buy \$4000 worth of gift cards. A percentage of the sales comes directly to the school. Gift cards are from all the stores we frequent, like grocery stores, gas stations and many more. We even have an app to make it easy. You shop your stores, and the school gets a percentage.

All money raised contributes to our school facilities, curriculum, enrichment and specialized programs into keeping the educational standards of our school at the highest level.
