SAINT KIERAN



St. Kieran (Ciaran) of Saighir was born in Ireland in 375AD.

Many legends exist concerning the events of Kieran's life. One says that when his mother was pregnant with Kieran, she had a dream that a star fell from heaven and came to rest on her. People said this meant the baby she carried would have a special purpose.

When Kieran was a child, he was kind and gentle. He loved animals, and they trusted him. Several of the stories about St. Kieran tell of his ability to tame wild animals, and he is often shown with a badger, a doe, and a fox. He is known for his healing powers for sick or injured animals.

Kieran wanted to learn more about God, so he went to Rome,

Many stories say that St. Patrick met with Kieran in Rome and commissioned him to return to Ireland and build a monastery.

Legend tells of St. Patrick giving Kieran a bell that rang for the first time when he reached the sight of a holy well in Saighir, and there he built his church. This became renowned as a sacred place.


