Title I Annual Parent Meeting (2026–2027)

Mountain Meadows Primary (MMP) & Capps Middle School (CMS)

- **Purpose of the Meeting**
 - Explain the school's Title I program.
 - Inform parents of their rights and opportunities to be involved in supporting student success.
- **What is Title I?**
 - A federal program that provides funding to schools with high numbers of students from low-income families. Both MMP and CMS Qualify for these funds
 - Funds are used to strengthen core academic programs and provide extra support for students who need it.
- **Parents' Rights**
 - Parents have the right to know:
 - Their child's teacher's qualifications and certification status.
 - Whether a teacher is working under emergency or provisional credentials.
 - Whether paraprofessionals are working with their child and their qualifications.
- **School Goals**
 - Provide paraprofessionals to assist with students
 - Provide summer, after school, and tutoring programs
 - Provide additional resources/materials to the students
- **School–Parent Compact**
 - A shared agreement between the school, parents, and students to support academic success.
 - Reviewed annually and updated based on student needs.
 - Parents are encouraged to provide input and collaborate on home learning strategies.
- **Communication with Families**
 - The school will maintain regular two-way communication through:
 - Homework folders
 - PowerSchool Parent/Student Portal
 - School website and grade updates
 - Parent-teacher conferences
 - IEP meetings (when applicable)
 - School Messenger notifications
 - School social media accounts
