What to Watch For

- Fever or sore throat
- Mouth sores or blisters
- Rash on hands, feet, or around the mouth
- · Loss of appetite or feeling unusually tired

If your child is experiencing any of these symptoms, **please keep them home** and **contact your pediatrician** for guidance.

Nelp Prevent the Spread

- Encourage frequent handwashing
- Teach children to cover coughs and sneezes
- **Disinfect** commonly touched surfaces at home
