



## BCSD BOARD VACANCY NOTICE

Mohave County Schools Superintendent John Warren will be accepting applications to fill a vacancy on the Bullhead City School District #15 governing board. The vacancy is due to the resignation of board member Judi Reed, and the appointment is for the remainder of a term through December 31, 2028.

According to state law, potential candidates must be registered voters who have lived within the District's boundaries at least one year. BCSD boundaries include all of Bullhead City and a sizable portion of surrounding unincorporated area north and east of the city. District boundaries for board eligibility are posted at <https://resources.mohave.gov/file/SchoolSuperintendent/SchoolDistrictsWAVE JTED25x36 2021.pdf>. Arizona school board members are unpaid.

Arizona county school superintendents may statutorily accept vacancy recommendations from school boards, or they may oversee their own application and review process. Warren has opted for the latter. Eligible and qualified candidates may contact his office in Kingman for more information at (928) 753-0747 during business hours or <https://forms.mohave.gov/Departments/Contact-Schools-Superintendent>. Once posted on the county website (<https://www.mohave.gov/departments/school-superintendent/school-board-member-appointment-process/>), Warren will have an application window of 14 to 21 days before vetting candidates and making a final selection.
