Oxford Preparatory School's 2026 – 2027 Open Enrollment Underway

Applications for new Kindergarten - 12th grade student enrollments for the 2026 - 2027 school year are now available at oxfordprep.org. Oxford Preparatory School (OPS) is an independent, tuition-free public charter school designed to mold students into future leaders through a rigorous curriculum that emphasizes community service and the development of an appreciation for the arts. OPS offers a college preparatory curriculum, a variety of competitive middle school and varsity athletic teams, and has an expansive campus located at 6041 Landis Rd. in Oxford.

Oxford Preparatory School invites families of prospective students to learn more about the unique offerings of the school. All prospective families are invited to the school's information session and tours on Tuesday, December 9th, at 6:30 P.M. (Upper School 7th – 12th grade) and Wednesday, January 7th, at 8:30 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. (Lower School K – 6th Grade). Information about both of these events are posted on the school's website (oxfordprep.org).

To be considered for a potential lottery, all applications must be submitted online by Monday, January 12, 2026. If more applications are received than available seats in any grade, a blind public lottery will be held on Saturday, January 24th, 2026. All students who choose to attend OPS must confirm enrollment by completing and submitting the enrollment form by Monday, March 2, 2026. After January 12th, applications received will be placed at the end of the waiting list as determined by the lottery.

Oxford Prep is planning a facility and enrollment expansion for the 2027 – 2028 school year.
