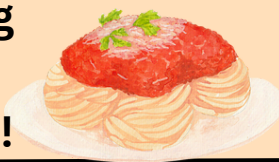
Spaghetti Dinner

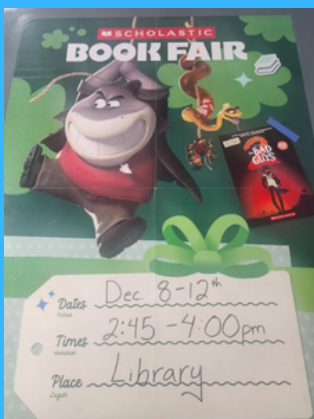


The Preschool Press
