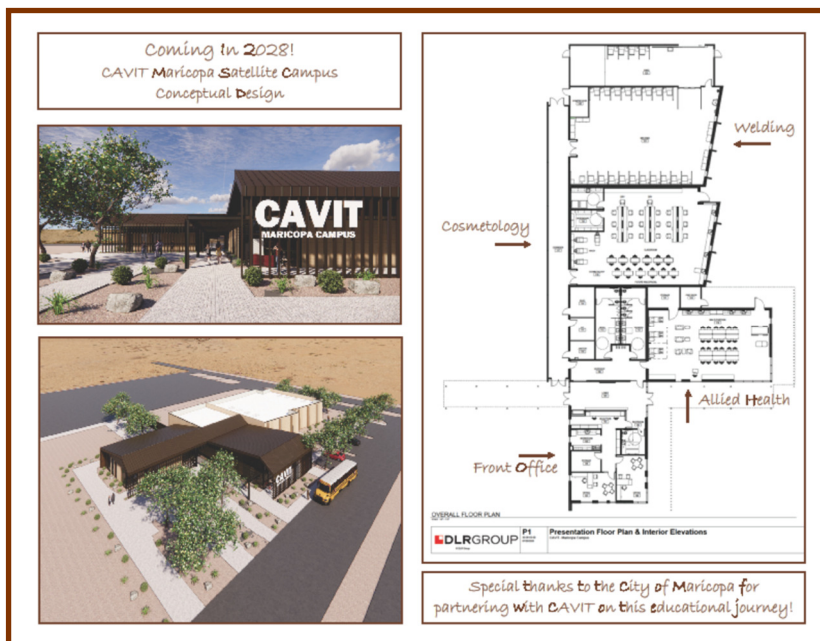

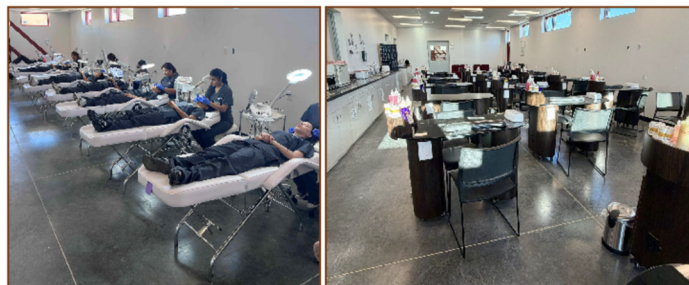
Dear Stakeholders,  
CAVIT started classes on July 22 with success given the challenge of opening a building, starting several new programs, planning for increased enrollment, and working with 17 high schools who have different school opening dates. Thanks are extended to our teachers and students for the smooth first days of school activity that included handing out uniforms, covering syllabi and classroom expectations, access to technology, and establishing CAVIT routines. We are thrilled to announce a 76% increase in student enrollment when comparing 2024 numbers to this year!

## Maricopa Campus Update

CAVIT is proud to unveil the Maricopa campus site plan that includes classroom and lab space for Allied Health, Cosmetology, and Welding programming. The Maricopa campus is located across the street from the Maricopa Stanfield Justice Court. It is anticipated that the campus will be open to students in July, 2028. Groundbreaking is planned for early spring, 2027. The campus will serve MUSD, A+ Charter, Heritage Academy, ESA, and home school 11-12th grade students. Future building phases are planned after the school's opening. We are excited to bring CAVIT to the Maricopa community to showcase a strong workforce presence!

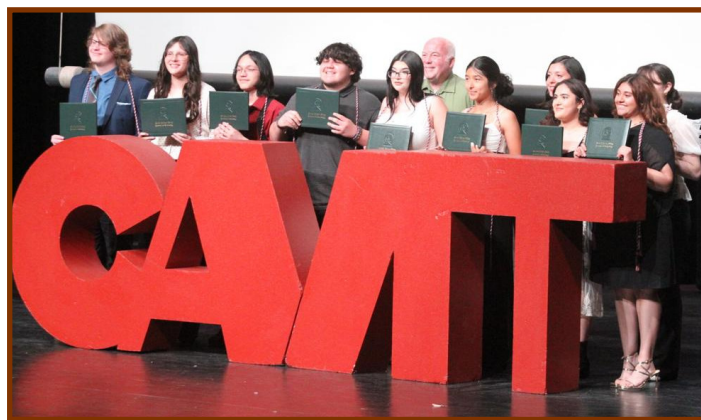


## Additional Classroom Space Opens

## 974 Industry Certifications

Last year's industry testing numbers resulted in a record for CAVIT that included 974 students earning a state or national license or certification. ## CAVIT Excels in State CTED Performance Audit

The Arizona Auditor's General Office is tasked with conducting a performance review on each Career Technical Education District. Auditors reviewed CAVIT financial and programming records during last year. CAVIT's report was published in June, 2026 and reflected eight findings found in three categories. Progress has been made in addressing compliance with the eight findings. A special section was added in CAVIT's audit that positively addressed our efforts to initiate and record industry certifications, student placement, and accountability measures that demonstrated positive program outcomes.



## New CAVIT Programming



CAVIT is excited to announce two new career training programs will be offered next school year.

**Emergency Medical Services** - Students will learn first response care and skills like CPR, vitals, bandaging, patient assessment, and other life-saving procedures.

**Medical Imaging** - Students will learn anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, radiation safety/protection, and introduction to X-ray and ultrasound equipment.

Both introductory programs will prepare students for postsecondary education and training.



## 9/11 Remembrance Ceremony
