The PARSS Advocacy Award was established to recognize outstanding leadership in legislative advocacy efforts on behalf of rural and small school districts consistent with the education policies supported by the Pennsylvania Association of Rural and Small Schools.

Awardees will be selected based on the description and evidence provided in the nomination form that shows how the individual is working to affect educational policy and legislation through effective advocacy for rural and small school districts at the local, state and/or national level. Examples include: keeping the local school board updated on legislative issues; initiating the adoption of resolutions and letters; networking with legislators and other state policymakers through letters, phone calls, and visits to create awareness about rural and small education concerns; educating others about the issues affecting rural and small school districts; encouraging others to become advocates for public education; collaborating with the media to garner positive attention for Pennsylvania's rural and small schools.
