
CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTING - DECEMBER 11

Christmas Program ATTIRE GUIDELINES

The term "Sunday best" in a school context refers to a specific, elevated dress code that typically requires students to wear neat, modest, and semi-formal clothing. This generally means avoiding casual items like jeans, t-shirts, and athletic wear in favor of traditional dress attire.

Guidelines


"Sunday best" includes the following types of clothing:

- Dresses and Skirts: Should meet length requirements (e.g., the hem must be within one inch of the top of the knee).
- Pants: Dress pants, slacks, or khakis are preferred. Baggy, sagging, or ripped pants are not allowed. Jeans are NOT allowed.
- Shirts: Collared shirts, such as polo shirts or dress shirts, are standard for boys and girls.
- Shoes: Closed-toe shoes, such as dress shoes, casual shoes, or clean athletic shoes, are required for safety and appearance. Flip-flops, slides, and high heels may not be permitted. No heels over an inch

Items Not Allowed:

- No shorts, or no leggings worn as pants (leggings may be allowed under a dress/skirt).
- No T-shirts, halter tops, or shirts with spaghetti straps, no sleeves or tube tops
- No hats or caps worn indoors.
- No clothing with inappropriate slogans, images, or messages.
- No tight-fitted clothing
- No short dresses or skirts (the hem must be within one inch of the top of the knee)
- No heels over an inch tall
