Second graders will be participating in their 1st Reconciliation on **Wednesday, February 25**, at 9:00am in St. Francis Chapel.




MOTHER-SON DANCE – POSTPONED





- **Yield to pedestrians.** Drive slowly and with caution, especially near crosswalks and walkways. Pedestrians always have the right-of-way. Be aware that students may not always be looking before crossing.
- **Be courteous and patient.** Aggressive driving, honking, or cutting in line makes the parking experience stressful for everyone.
