REMINDER: Please call the school office to let us know if your child is absent.



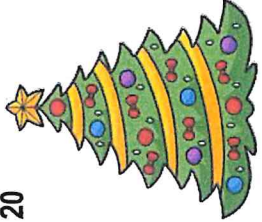
