Hello Nazareth School Community,

With the academic year underway, our campus parking lots are busier than ever. We would like to issue a friendly reminder about our campus parking etiquette to ensure a safe and efficient experience for everyone. Your cooperation helps us maintain a smooth traffic flow and a respectful community environment.

Please review and observe the following guidelines:

- Park within designated lines only. Do not take up more than one space or park in non-designated areas. Creating your own parking spot can cause obstructions and makes it more difficult for others to find parking.
- Respect auction winner/restricted spaces. Avoid parking in areas designated for faculty/staff, visitors, service vehicles, or auction winner parking spots (signage for spots are displayed) unless you are authorized to do so.
- **Keep fire lanes clear at all times.** The yellow or red-striped lanes must remain open for emergency vehicles. Even briefly parking in a fire lane is a hazard and is against regulations.
- · Do not leave children unattended in the car.
- **Do not block traffic flow.** During peak drop-off and pick-up times, avoid stopping in the middle of a lane to load or unload. Be patient and wait your turn in the appropriate drop-off zone to prevent traffic jams.
- Yield to pedestrians. Drive slowly and with caution, especially near crosswalks and walkways. Pedestrians always have the right-of-way. Be aware that students may not always be looking before crossing.
- Be courteous and patient. Aggressive driving, honking, or cutting in line makes the parking experience stressful for everyone. Kindness and patience go a long way toward a safer, more pleasant environment. Thank you for your attention to this important matter. By working together, we can ensure our campus remains a safe and welcoming place for all.
