B. Specific Items of District Business which require Action

a. PUBLIC HEARING:

- i. **First review of the Yavapai County Curriculum *Promoting Health Among Teens! (Abstinence Only)* presented by Laurel Abdelnour from the Yavapai County Health Department.** Focusing on knowledge, attitudes and skills that encourage and assist young people in implementing abstinence in their relationships. The curriculum presented will be available for review for 60 days before final request for approval and is an updated version of what has previously been approved. Links to the curriculum with 30-day Sample Access have been on the district website since March 2, 2026. The second Public Hearing will be on April 14, 2026 with final approval being requested on May 12, 2026.

b. Request to discuss and approve the following field trips which are more than 50 miles from the school district:

- i. Medieval Times, Scottsdale – 5th Grade (estimated transportation cost \$277.27 to be paid from tax credit.)

c. Request to discuss and approve Gifted Scope and Sequence. This document outlines the identification process and provision of gifted services as required by ARS §15-779.

d. Request to discuss and approve the termination of Health Insurance Coverage with KAIROS due to 11.2% increase for the 2026-2027 year. Coverage will end June 30, 2026. The district has received another quote from ASBAIT that came in lower than current year rates (as presented). The district will bring back final paperwork to officially approve ASBAIT for our Health Insurance for 2026-2027 and final district contributions in April.

e. Request to discuss and approve the Beaver Creek Retirement Incentive Program Packet for 2026-2027 school year. This is an annual document that we review and approve for potential staff who may be interested in participating in the Retire/Rehire Program.
