The Kindergarten promotion ceremony will be on May 19 at 7:00 p.m.

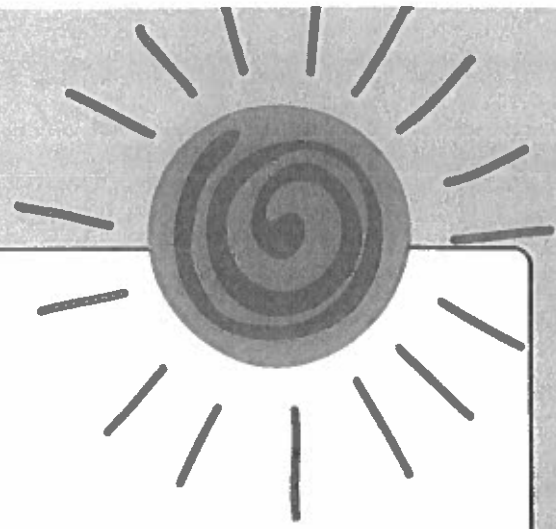

KIDS EAT FREE ALL SUMMER LONG!

School may be out but meals are still available at participating Summer Sites!

Children need good nutrition all year long. All Arizona kids and teens (ages 18 and under) are eligible for free meals through the Summer Food Service Program at participating schools and community sites across Arizona during the summer break. Meals include breakfast, lunch, dinner or snack and vary with each location. No applications or paperwork are needed. All you have to do is show up to a participating meal service site during the advertised dates and times of operation and ANY present child age 18 and younger will be served a meal, free of charge.

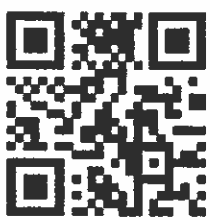
Summer feeding sites are located throughout the state of Arizona. They offer a combination of breakfasts, lunches, snacks, and suppers. In some rural areas, these meals may be delivered or picked up. **To find a participating site near you, please visit azfoodbanks.org/summer-meals/.**

Your child[ren] may be eligible to receive money for groceries this summer! Have you heard of the Summer Electronic Benefit Transfer Program (Summer-EBT/SUN Bucks)? SUN Bucks provides grocery-buying benefits to low-income families with school-aged children who lose access to free or reduced-price school meals when schools are closed for the summer. 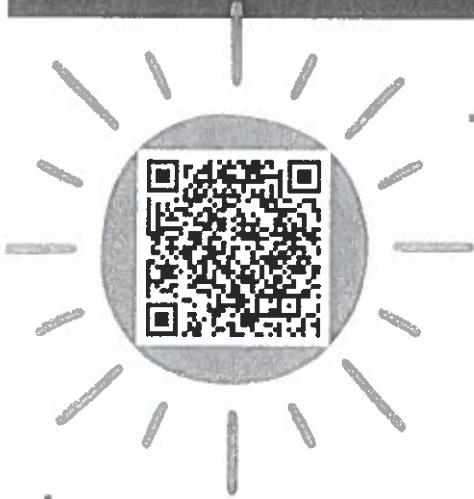

No Meal Application, No Problem...

How to receive SUN Bucks for students who attend schools that do not collect Household Applications for Meal Benefits



The information collected on meal applications for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) can qualify students for SUN Bucks. However, if your school doesn't collect meal applications, you may fill out a SUN Bucks application to see if your child is eligible for this grocery buying benefit.

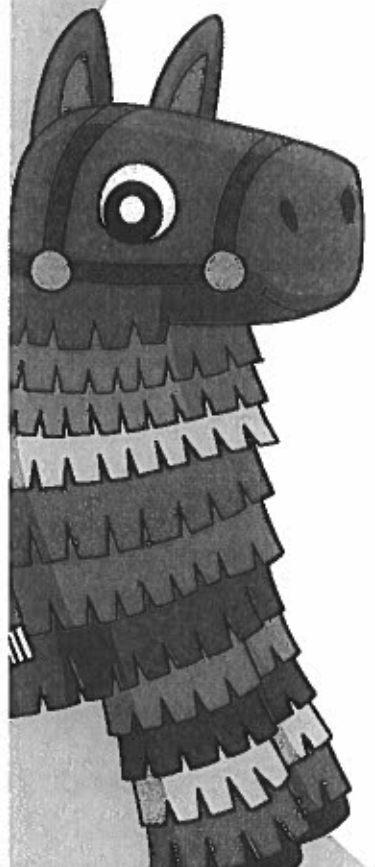
