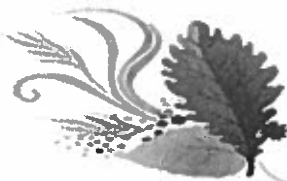

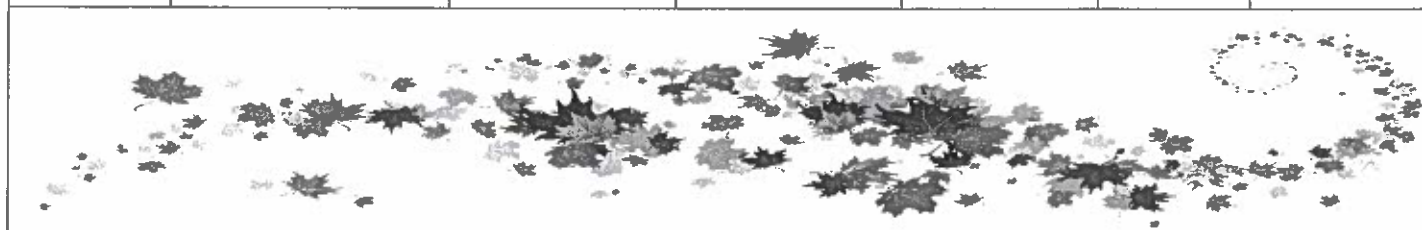

ANNUAL ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION and COMMUNICATION FOR EMPLOYEES, PARENTS and CONTRACTORS

In compliance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) 40CFR 763 subpart E (763.93(e)(10), and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Asbestos in Construction Standard (29CFR 1926.1101), the Beaver Creek ESD #26 submits the following Annual Asbestos Notification and Communication to inform employees, parents, and contractors conducting work in buildings owned or leased by the district. Information regarding the presence, location, and quantity of asbestos-containing building materials (ACBMs) inside District buildings is summarized as follows:

- The types, location, and amounts of ACBMs in each of the campus school buildings have been updated by Tallpines Environmental Consulting Co. Flagstaff, an independent environmental consultant. The original 1988 & 2012 inspection reports and management plans are archived at the Beaver Creek ESD #26 District Office located on the Beaver Creek School campus. Tallpine's report entitled 2024 AHERA 3-Year Re-inspection of the Beaver Creek School, dated June 29, 2024 can be inspected by making an appointment with the school office.
- AHERA 3-Year Re-inspections (40CFR 763.85) are meant to address the locations and conditions of friable (easily crushed with hand pressure) and non-friable ACBMs in a school. If damaged or significantly damaged friable ACBMs are present in a school, the AHERA Management Planner will generate response actions (40CFR 763.90) to protect human health and the environment, and the Beaver Creek ESD #26 shall respond and implement the recommended response actions in a timely manner. The Management Plan (40CFR 763.93) for each school building contains a general inventory, AHERA reports, response actions and implementation, AHERA accreditations, an operations and maintenance (O&M) plan, initial notifications, cost estimations, ongoing record keeping, and annual notifications. The Management Plan has been updated by Tallpines and is available for review.
- The AHERA regulations require schools to "ensure that workers and building occupants, or their legal guardians, are informed at least once each school year regarding inspections, response actions, and post-response action activities including periodic re-inspections and surveillances that are planned or in progress" (40CFR 763.84(c)). In addition, ensure that contractors who may come in contact with ACBMs are provided information regarding the locations of ACBMs.

NOTIFICACION ANUAL DE ASBESTOS y COMUNICACION PARA EMPLEADOS, PADRES y CONTRATISTAS

En cumplimiento de la Ley de Respuesta a Emergencias por Peligros de Asbesto (AHERA) 40CFR 763 subparte E (763.93(e)(10)), y la Administración de Seguridad y Salud Ocupacional (OSHA) Asbesto en la Construcción Estándar (29CFR 1926.1101), el Beaver Creek ESD # 26 presenta la siguiente Notificación Anual de Asbesto y Comunicación para informar a los empleados, padres y contratistas que realizan trabajos en edificios de propiedad o arrendados por el distrito. La información con respecto a la presencia, ubicación, y cantidad de materiales de construcción que contienen asbesto (ACBMs) dentro de los edificios del Distrito se resume como sigue:

- Los tipos, ubicación, y cantidades de ACBMs en cada uno de los edificios escolares del campus han sido actualizados por Tallpines Environmental Consulting Co. Flagstaff, un consultor ambiental independiente. Los informes de inspección originales de 1988 y 2012 y los planes de gestión están archivados en la Oficina del Distrito Beaver Creek ESD #26 ubicada en el campus de la Escuela Beaver Creek. El informe de Tallpine titulado 2024 AHERA 3-Year Re-inspección de la Escuela Beaver Creek, de fecha 29 de junio 2024 puede ser inspeccionado por hacer una cita con la oficina de la escuela.
- Las reinspecciones trienales de AHERA (40CFR 763.85) tienen por objeto determinar la ubicación y el estado de los ACBM friables (que se pueden aplastar fácilmente con la mano) y no friables en una escuela. Si ACBMs friables dañados o significativamente dañados están presentes en una escuela, el Planificador de Gestión de AHERA generará acciones de respuesta (40CFR 763.90) para proteger la salud humana y el medio ambiente, y el Beaver Creek ESD #26 responderá e implementará las acciones de respuesta recomendadas de manera oportuna. El Plan de Manejo (40CFR 763.93) para cada edificio escolar contiene un inventario general, informes AHERA, acciones de respuesta e implementación, acreditaciones AHERA, un plan de operaciones y mantenimiento (O&M), notificaciones iniciales, estimaciones de costos, mantenimiento continuo de registros y notificaciones anuales. El Plan de Gestión ha sido actualizado por Tallpines y está disponible para su revisión.
- La normativa AHERA exige a los centros escolares que "garanticen que los trabajadores y ocupantes del edificio, o sus tutores legales, sean informados al menos una vez cada curso escolar sobre las inspecciones, acciones de respuesta y actividades de acción posteriores a la respuesta, incluidas las reinspecciones y vigilancias periódicas que estén previstas o en curso" (40CFR 763.84(c)). Además, asegúrese de que los contratistas que puedan entrar en contacto con los ACBM reciban información sobre la ubicación de los ACBM.
